INDEMNITY FORM

Whereas, I _____ (name in block letters) will willingly be participating in a Bridgestone/Nissan Off-Road Club (hereafter referred to as the Club) meeting/outing, I acknowledge that in participating in these activities I shall be subjecting myself, passengers and my vehicle to danger and the possibility of personal injury, loss or support and / or the loss of my life or passengers lives, and / or the loss or damage of personal possessions.

Now therefore, I _____ (name in block letters) do hereby acknowledge that I have freely and voluntarily accepted fully the risk to myself and do hereby on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns forever discharge, release and indemnify, hold harmless and absolve the Club, their committee, member clubs and their members, land owners, and any other person involved in the above activities where such activities constitute a negligent act or omission of the Club from any claim or claims of whatsoever nature prior to and including the date/s of the activities and particularly as a result of any activity of whatsoever nature in which the Club is in any way party to.

And I do further indemnify the Club against any claim or claims, which may be preferred against them by any other person or body arising out of my actions aforementioned, and in particular against claims made against the Club for any claim or claims preferred against them by my dependants.

I acknowledge that I have given this indemnity form to each of my passengers and that they have accepted the conditions as set out above.

SAFETY RULES:

1. Consuming of alcoholic beverages by drivers are forbidden and any person not adhering to this rule will not be allowed to participate any further in the event and will be asked to leave the track;
2. Drivers and passengers are obliged to obey normal and general traffic rules while on the track e.g. seat belts must always be fastened except when deep and or free flowing water crossings are attempted;
3. Drivers are responsible for the behavior of passengers and no passenger will be transported in a manner that can create a safety risk to themselves and or others (people including children standing at the back of an open vehicle will not be allowed);
4. Driving in a manner that is dangerous to co-participants, passengers, marshals and spectators will not be tolerated and drivers that make themselves guilty of this will not be allowed to participate any further in the event and will be asked to leave the track;
5. Drivers that do not obey marshals instructions will not be allowed to participate any further in the event and will be asked to leave the track;
6. In the event of a vehicle recovery situation the marshal in charge of a specific obstacle and or part of the track will take charge of the recovery and will ensure that the recovery is done in a safe and controlled manner;

VEHICLES:

1. All vehicles must be equipped with proper recovery points front and rear, bolted to the chassis – a normal tow ball is not a recovery point, but the “ball and pin” type is accepted;
2. All vehicles should be equipped with basic safety, health, recovery equipment. e.g.
 - a. First Aid Kit;
 - b. Tow Rope – suitable for the weight of own vehicle, to recover the vehicle safely;
 - c. Properly rated shackles to attached tow rope to recovery points;
 - d. Jack;
 - e. Puncture repair kit;
 - f. Tyre inflation device;
 - g. Basic spares and tool kit;
